## SUMMARY OF FUNDING FOR PE AND SPORTS SPENDING 2018/19

- $\bullet$  East Staffordshire Sports Partnership To maintain participation in competitions and collaborate with PE specialists across the partnership £1,200
- Resources New equipment purchased for PE lessons/ Playground Leaders/ Sports Day £3,000
- After School Clubs & Active Lunchtimes- Burton Albion to deliver a subsided after school club on Wednesdays and Thursdays throughout the year and Active Lunchtime Clubs £7,000
- **Professional Development Opportunities** Classroom cover to allow the PE Co-Ordinator/other staff to attend meeting/ to provide coaching and team teaching alongside other non-PE specialist staff £1,000
- Transports to Sporting Events Coach costs to Competitions/ Sporting festivals £800
- KS1 Gymnastics Specialist coach to deliver the KS1 Gymnastics over 7 weeks at Uttoxeter Gym Club alongside Classroom teacher-£500
- Sports Week Whole school trip to Tamworth Snow Dome to participate in winter sport activities -£1,000
- Teaching assistant to provide First Aid cover during Active Lunchtime and After School Clubs £930

- Following KS1 Gymnastics specialist teaching, some of the children are now receiving lessons at Uttoxeter Gymnastics Club.
- KS2 children receiving a widened curriculum due to the increased knowledge/confidence of the PE coordinator - rounders/volleyball
- New activities offered for after school clubs, seeing some children attend for the first time archery
- As a result of Sports Week, several children have since return to the Snow Dome to continue learning about the winter sports.
- All KS1 and KS2 children attended 'Multi-Skills' and were able to learn and experience different sports for the first time
- All school children actively participated in our Comic Relief Danceathon
- All children took part in Active Lunchtime Clubs and Year 3 Sports Leaders trained in leading Active Games Sessions from September 2019.
