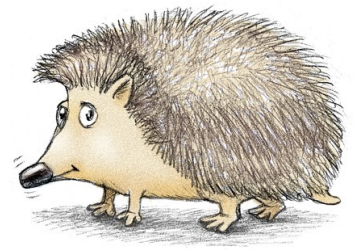
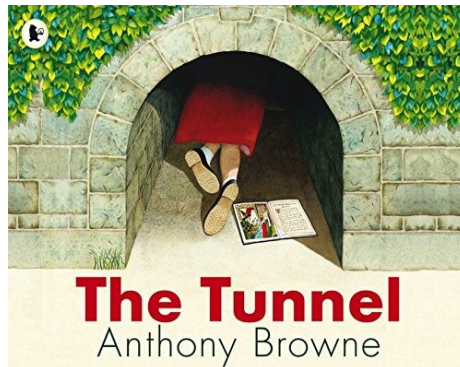


Hedgehogs Fact sheet

I hope you all had an enjoyable half term and are ready for a busy and exciting half term ahead. Our topic this half term is 'The Tunnel'.



English

As Writers we will be . . . exploring 'The Tunnel'. We will predict what we think will happen in the story, explore the plot of the story as well as the characters. We will aim to plan and write our own complete story based around a tunnel.

As we get closer to Christmas we will also write a letter to Santa Claus and explore the Christmas Story.

We will continue to develop our knowledge of spellings, grammar and punctuation, particularly focusing on the correct use of capital letters, full stops and conjunctions.

Maths

As Mathematicians we will be . . .

- Finding number bonds within 10, to 10 and to 100.
- Exploring fact families.
- Count one more and one less.
- Finding 10 more and 10 less than any given number.
- Adding.
- Subtracting.
- Finding the difference.
- Adding 3 1 - digit numbers.
- Comparing addition and subtraction.
- Recognising, naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes.
- Making patterns with 2D and 3D shapes.
- Recognising coins and notes.
- Counting and selecting money.
- Making the same amount of money in different ways.

We will apply our learnt skills to problem solving and reasoning activities on a weekly basis.

Children are continually practicing their maths target within school. These are checked as regularly as possible and your support practicing these at home is very much appreciated. You will be informed of your child's new maths target via Seesaw.

Science

As Scientists we will be . . . continuing to explore living things and their habitats.

ICT

As computer scientists we will be . . . exploring how to film a short video.

Topic

As historians we will be . . . exploring and re-telling The Gunpowder Plot.

As artists we will be . . . exploring Banksy and street art. Particularly looking at how art can portray a message. As we move into December we also complete a range of Christmas crafts.

PE

As sportsmen and sportswomen we will be . . . continuing to developing our fitness and game skills by exploring hockey. Children will need their usual PE kit in school every day and could you please ensure it is clearly labelled. Earrings need to be removed on Thursdays please.

PSHE

This half term we will be exploring the values of Creativity and Curiosity.

Homework

The children will take home their reading books and records every day and are encouraged to read regularly at home. We would ask you to comment in their reading records when they have read to you.

The children are able to change their individual reading book everyday.

They will have weekly spellings to learn which will be checked on Fridays.

Homework will be given out every Thursday via Seesaw and handed in by the following Monday via Seesaw please to be marked.

Maths targets will be practised regularly in school and your support with these is much appreciated.

Children will earn dojo points for reading at home, completing homework and doing well on their spelling checks. Every time the children earn 30 dojo points they can choose a treat out of the box.

In RE lessons this half term children will be exploring the question, why does Christmas matter to Christians?
