


Curriculum Information

Rationale

Our topic for this half term is The Great Fire of London. This will develop children's understanding of major events in British history and builds upon previous learning about The Gunpowder Plot. This topic focus brings together a range of curriculum areas in an exciting and interesting way.

English

As Writers we will be . . . exploring 'The Great Fire of London'. We will use various texts and videos to help us to research this historical event. We will also explore Samuel Pepys and we will aim to write our own diary entry about this event. We will continue to develop our SPAG skills.



Maths

As Mathematicians we will be . . .

- Comparing and ordering groups of objects and numbers.
- Adding and subtracting.
- Comparing number sentences.
- Identifying one more and one less than a given number.
- Exploring multiplication and division.
- Identifying odd and even numbers.
- Exploring tally charts, pictograms and block diagrams.

Science

As Scientists we will be . . . exploring materials.

Music

As musicians we will be . . . exploring 'pitch'.

Topic

As geographers we will be . . . exploring London.
As historians we will be . . . exploring 'The Great Fire of London', children will develop their sense of chronology and consider why the Great Fire happened; its results; and the different ways it is represented. They will also look at 'The Great Fire of London' through the eyes of Samuel Pepys.

As designers we will be . . . creating our own Tudor houses.

RE

We are exploring the question - What is faith and what difference does it make?

PE

As sportsmen and sportswomen we will be . . . focusing on dance based on the Great Fire of London.

The children will continue to have weekly spellings to learn which will be sent out every Friday and checked the following Friday. It is very important that the children continue to read everyday. They could read anything they would like, books from home, books online (Oxford Owl), magazines etc.
