Curriculum Information Hedgehogs Spring 2



<u>Rationale</u>

Our topic for this half term is The Great Paper Caper. This will develop children's literacy skills in an exciting and interesting way. It will also support discussions during PSHE lessons.

English

As Writers we will be . . . exploring 'The Great Paper Caper'. We will be consolidating our learning around punctuation, as well as revisiting and exploring conjunctions, adjectives and expanded noun phrases. We will aim to write a set of instructions for how to make a paper aeroplane.

Maths

Science

As Scientists we will be . . . exploring different types of animals.

KE

We are exploring the question - Why does Easter matter to Christians?

PE

As sportsmen and sportswomen we will be . . . learning about the effects exercise has on our body. We will explore different activities to help to develop our health and fitness.

Homework

The children will take home their reading books and records every day and are encouraged to read regularly at home. We would ask you to comment in their reading records when they have read to you. They are able to change their individual reading book everyday in school.

The children will have weekly spellings to learn which will be checked on Fridays.
