Please post any work or comments on Seesaw for us to reply to. If you are unsure of your login codes please ask. We also use Seesaw to send announcements and messages so please check it regularly.

We will also use this to ask for evidence of things your child might be doing at home that we might not see in school, for example, some aspects of physical development. This helps us to gain a holistic picture of your child. Thank you for your support with this.

Reading Books

Reading books will be sent home each Monday so please ensure they are sent in for us to change.

Nursery children will bring home a story book to share with a grown up. Have fun sharing it together and discussing the pictures.

Reception children will bring home picture books to begin with. Please encourage them to talk about the pictures in their books and answer questions relating to these. As we continue with our phonics sessions and the children build up knowledge of letter sounds we will send home books with simple words and captions. Please keep rereading these over the week to develop their confidence and fluency. They will also bring home a book to share and enjoy with an adult.

Reception children will also have sounds and words sent home as they are taught.

Please go over these with your child regularly so they begin to name and recognise the sounds.
