# **Reading Books**

We will be changing reading books each Monday. Please ensure that you record books read in the diary and send in every week for us to change. Our recent fundraising and PTFA support has enabled us to purchase new books - please ensure all books are looked after and returned to school.

Reception children will bring home a decodable book which they will be able to decode and read as it will contain sounds your child recognises confidently. Please read this each night to

Nursery children will bring home a story book to share with a grown up. Have fun sharing it together and discussing the pictures.
