
Badgers' Autumn 2 2022 Curriculum Overview







Rational: Our next topic will see us explore the World's biggest sporting event:

FIFA WORLD CUP Qat_ar2022



English

As a reader we will read a book by Helena Pielichaty called 'Do Goalkeepers Wear Tiaras?' In this story, we meet a girl called Megan who is fed up of not being noticed in football practice so decides to make her own team called GIRLS F.C!

As a writer we will write letters to Gareth Southgate and the England team wishing the players the best of luck for the upcoming tournament. We will follow their progress closely and write match reports and newspaper articles following their matches. We will also write our own pre-match speeches to motivate our team to glory!

As a speaker we will perform our speeches to the class using intonation and expression. We will also have lines to learn for our Christmas play which we will perform in front of a large audience.

We also have our own reading and writing targets, which we will get regular opportunities to practise.

Maths

As a mathematician we will:

- Use place value to mentally add and subtract
- Make an exchange to add and subtract over 10/100/1000
- Use a variety of methods to add and subtract 3/4 digit numbers
- Use inverse operations to solve missing number problems
- Estimate the answer of a calculation
- Solve two-step word problems

We also have our own targets to practise using our number cards. These targets will be regularly reviewed and changed when the target has been met.

Science

As Scientists we will learn about the human body including the digestive system and the different types of teeth we have. We will explore questions that help us understand their special functions. Also, we will discuss the importance of healthy eating and looking after our teeth.

PE

As athletes we will be playing football! We will develop our ability to control, pass and move with the ball using our feet. We will also understand the basic rules of the game and participate in some small matches.

We usually have PE on a Thursday afternoon, but children should have their <u>outdoor</u> PE kit in school every day. This should include a **jumper** and a **pair of trainers**.

RE

As religious learners we will explore the question: 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'

In doing so, we will explore the life and teachings of Jesus and his impact on the disciples. We will discover how Jesus showed love and forgiveness to unlikely people. We will explore how Christians try to follow his example and teachings today.

Homework

Homework will be uploaded onto Seesaw every Thursday and is due in the following Monday. Spellings will be uploaded on a Friday and will be checked in school the following week.

Children will take home their reading book every day and are encouraged to read regularly at home. We ask parents/carers to comment in their reading diaries when they have read, this will earn them a dojo point!

Geography

As geographers we will identify and locate the countries that are in the World Cup. We will learn how to use the eight-points on a compass to describe where each country is located. We will also research the capital city of Qatar (Doha).

Computing

As a computer user we will learn about databases and understand how to input data into a spreadsheet. We will use this information to create our own football comparison cards.

Languages

As a French speaker we will use adjectives to describe shape, size and colour. We will also create some Christmas artwork inspired by the cut-outs of French artist, Henri Matisse.

RHE & PSHE

In this unit we will learn about health and wellbeing. We will understand that a healthy lifestyle includes physical activity, a balanced diet, rest and relaxation.
