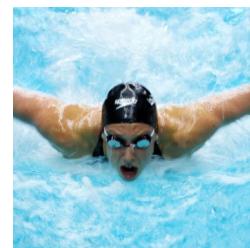
GB Olympic Swimmer Amy Smith Visit to Hutchinson!
