Phonics



Summer 1 – Curriculum Information

Topic	Focus texts	Rationale
All Creatures Great and Small		As we think about Spring and new life at this time of year, we will learning about different animals, their habitats and life cycles.
Communication and Language	We will: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listen to and retell the story using actions and repeated vocabulary.• Listen and join in with regular Storytime.• Learn new vocabulary linked to different celebrations and events.	
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	This half term we will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Making healthy choices about what we eat.• Developing our independence as we select our own resources.• Talking about our work and things we have done well.• Continuing to keep our classroom tidy and look after our belongings.	
RHE	Theme – Caring	

Physical Development	This term we will be continuing to learn the correct way to hold one handed tools including scissors, pencils and cutlery. We will also be learning to use hammers safely. We will be continuing to practise our letter formation. In PE we will focus on manipulation and co-ordination.
Literacy	Nursery will be making their own marks and beginning to give meaning to them. We will be retelling stories and beginning to learn some letter sounds. Reception will be learning new sounds during our daily phonics' sessions. We will be writing short sentences and retelling stories and events. We will be using our phonics knowledge to read short sentences, reading some words by sight.
Mathematics	Nursery will complete lots of practical activities using simple shapes. We will be looking at number 5 and using one more and one less to compare amounts. Reception will continue to follow the White Rose Maths Scheme. We will be looking at how larger numbers are composed. We will order numbers and explore patterns including doubles, odd and even. We will also be continuing our quick recall of number bonds to 5.
Understanding the World	This half term we will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning about special events – St George's Day and the Coronation of King Charles. • Making our own map of the zoo. • Planting seeds and observing them as they grow. • Learning about the life cycle of the butterfly. • Learning about dinosaurs and the famous palaeontologist Mary Anning.
Expressive Arts and Design	This half term we will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Creating our own Spring pictures selecting different resources. • Drawing different animals through careful observation. • Making our own butterfly pictures. • Making a Coronation Crown. • Learning songs for the Coronation.
RE	Nursery- Special Places Reception – What happens in our Church?

Play different number games looking at the number patterns.



Write about things they have been doing away from school.



Plant their own seeds or bulbs to grow flowers or vegetables.
