NEW MUSICAL THEATRE CLASSES Learn to Sing Act & DANCE in the one session

The Vivienne Shelley Dance studios are excited to announce starting on Friday 8th March will be our new junior musical theatre classes for students aged 10 and under.

As an introduction to the classes we will be having 4 free taster sessions, so pupils can come along to try out the classes. Free taster sessions will be March 8th & 15th and April 12th & 19th. Pupils are welcome to do all tasters sessions or as many as they can attend.

After the taster sessions the cost of Classes will be £12.50 a week. £5 per individual class.
